

DEBUSSY: SCOTTISH MARCH (arr. Roth)

arrangement for string orchestra of the *Marche Écossaise* by Claude Debussy
first performed by the Scottish Ensemble, Clio Gould (director), Palace Theatre, Kilmarnock, 4 September 2004

Debussy composed his *Marche écossaise sur un theme populaire* for piano duet in 1891 as the result of a commission from General Meredith Reid. His treatment of the traditional Scots tune (*The Earl of Ross*) provided by Reid, combined with his own developing style produced a work of great charm. This arrangement for string orchestra was made for the Scottish Ensemble who gave its first performance at The Palace Theatre, Kilmarnock on 4 September 2004.
